The following is current information about graduation rates for first-time freshmen at Tennessee Tech University. Each freshman cohort consists of all first-time, full-time freshmen who entered the University in the Fall semester or the immediately preceding Summer.

Notes:

2. In accordance with conventional practice for retention and graduation rate calculations, a student who becomes deceased before receiving a degree is removed from the cohort. Consequently, the class size and graduation percentages in this report can change in subsequent iterations of this report.
