

	served as director of the Upper Cumberland Institute for many years.
	Dating from 1935 to 2000, the collection is comprised of textual records,
	photographs, slides, microfilm, and cassette audio recordings, and videos.

History

Dr. Homer Kemp was a professor within the Department of English at Tennessee Technological University. His research and interests included local folklore and the Wilder-Davidson strike. He was the director of the Upper Cumberland Institute at Tennessee Tech and helped collect folklore and songs from around the Upper Cumberland. Kemp created a documentary on the Wilder-Davidson strike, using oral histories, photographs, and videos.

Kemp also was involved in the development of the Big South Fork National River and Recreation Center in Oneida, TN, and had interests in the development of architecture in the Upper Cumberland. He conducted architectural surveys, later released as photographs with historical notes in the book, *Upper Cumberland Historical Architecture* (Hillsboro Press, 2002).

Scope and Contents

The Dr. Homer Kemp records date from 1935 to 2000, with the bulk of the materials dating 1985 to 1987. Comprised of textual records, photographs, slides, microfilm, audio recordings, and video, the collection spans over several areas of interest held by Kemp. The container list is in alphabetical order, with the bulk of the materials relate to Upper Cumberland Institute and Wilder-Davidson.

The Upper Cumberland Institute materials contain correspondence and tape logs from various interviews to obtain local folklore and songs. The Tennessee State Library and Archives microfilm are of the architectural surveys done of the Upper Cumberland counties, while additional media contain various interviews with histories and songs from the region.

The Wilder-Davidson materials include drafts, interview transcripts and recording logs, along with photographs and slides of Wilder, TN and the Fentress Coal Company.

There are also copies of the Big South Fork National River and Recreation Area Master Plan, and their Appendices, along with the recording logs from the Tennessee State Parks Folklife Project in 1979.
