After First Year:

- Decentralized advising
- Professional and/or faculty advisor depending on student's major/college

First Year Advising - The Launchpad Advantage

- Professional advisor trained to work with first-year students and support their ongoing transition
- One location for first-year advisement regardless of major
- We work closely with department advisors
- Help students build skills in utilizing resources
- Frequent communication regarding deadlines, opportunities, and resources
- Walk-in hours
- Workshops tailored to first-year students
- Partnership with Center for Career Development
