PROGRAM INFORMATION

A four-year, 120 credit hour, on-campus degree program built around a five-semester clinical sequence. Fully accredited by CCNE, the BSN program prepares students to sit for the NCLEX-RN licensure exam. Three semesters of prerequisites lead into our clinical sequence with weekly placements throughout Middle Tennessee and the Upper Cumberland.



ADMISSION INFORMATION

"Direct Flight" guarantees clinical admission to new freshmen for students meeting Presidential Scholarship criteria — a 3.4 HS GPA and 23 ACT Comp. Everyone else will be reviewed based on college GPA, science grades, HESI A2 exam scores and previous healthcare experience at the end of their freshman year. Up to 100 students are admitted each fall and spring - apply June 1–Aug 1 for a spring start, or Dec 1–Feb 1 for fall.
