## Psychiatric/Mental Health Online MSN

Our MSN-PMHNP program is a fully-online, 46 credit hour degree that includes all coursework required to seek Advanced Practice licensure with a focus on Psychiatric/Mental Health care. Course loads are flexible and most students complete the program in 7-8 semesters/2-2.5 years of enrollment with two courses a semester. Courses are taught completely by TNTech's Graduate Nursing Faculty members and we offer assistance with securing clinical placements.

### A dmission Requirements

- An unencumbered license to practice as a Registered Nurse in Tennessee or in the state in which your clinical assignments will be completed.
- A Bachelor's degree in Nursing with an overall GPA of 3.0. Provisional admission for students with below a 3.0 may be considered only on a case-by-case basis.
- Completion of or planned enrollment in a statistics course.
- Please note that the PMHNP program admits for the Fall semester only.

  - ◆ At least one professional reference
  - ◆ At least one educational reference
