Well-written goals state exactly what is to be accomplished including active verbs that describe actions to be preformed.

State how you are going to measure progress toward and achieve your goals using standard agreeable metrics.

Goals should be within your potential but contain stretch qualities to challenge progress.

Goals need to be relevant to your program's scope and outcome. Align goals with the mission and vision of your department, college, and university.

Goals need to have a start and end date for a point of reference. Set a realistic, ambitious end date for task prioritization.
