CITI Training for Principal Investigator (PI) & Co-Principal Investigator (Co-PI)

This training is required for anyone serving as a Principal Investigator, Co-Principal Investigator, or Faculty Supervisor on all IRB Applications for Research Involving Human Subjects.

The training should take a few hours to complete; however, it does not need to be completed in one sitting. It consists of 16 brief modules, each with a two- to five-question quiz. All quizzes must be passed with an 80% or better.
