FY24 Federal Agenda Information

- Information on Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) along with templates for CDS Relevant Spending and Plus Up requests follow.
- Eligible account information and templates follow.
- Note that each form when completed, should be submitted to Jill Dicey (jdicey@tntech.edu).
- CDS or Plus Up applications and CDS budgets should not exceed 2 pages each (with no less than 12 pt font and 1 inch margins).
- Also, the two letters of support required for CDS projects are not required at this time. After final decisions on Tennessee Tech selections, then two letters of support will be requested at that time.

FY24 Congressionally Directed Spending/ Community Project Funding Guidelines

- Congress made the decision to restore Congressionally Directed Spending (earmarks) in FY22.
- A limited number of appropriations accounts are eligible and proposed projects should be generally focused on *community service efforts*.
- The House website states, "Community engagement and support is crucial in determining which projects are worthy of Federal funding. Only projects with *demonstrated community support* will be considered."

<u>House</u>	<u>Subcommittee</u>	<u>Senate</u>
Dol (Department of Labor) Employment and Training Administration — direct services to individuals to enhance employment opportunities and have a link to State or local workforce investment system. HRSA (Health Resources and Services Administration) Health Facilities Construction and Equipment — can cover cost of construction, renovation, or capital equipment for facilities for provision of health, mental health, substance abuse services, training of health professionals. No salary funding allowed. SAMSHA (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services) Mental Health, Substance Abuse Treatment, Substance Abuse Prevention—Focus on promotion and prevention projects. ESEA (Elementary and Secondary Education Act) Innovation & Improvement — Instructional services, after school programs, curricula development, teacher training, early childhood ed. FIPSE (Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Ed) — Hiring/training of faculty, establish and improve degree programs, improve teacher prep, develop and improve curricula, establish research and training centers. Sub-grants not allowed.	Labor, HHS, Education	Dol ETA is eligible HRSA is eligible Administration for Children and Families — Child abuse prevention and social services research is eligible SAMSHA is eligible Administration for Community Living — Aging and disability services programs ESEA Innovation and Improvement is eligible FIPSE is eligible
DOT Highway Infrastructure – Road must be on the State Transportation Improvement Program list. HUD Community Development Fund (Economic Development Initiative, EDI) – Projects that are focused on economic and community development.
