Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University Information

The top seven candidates in each of the Mr. and Miss Tennessee Tech University elections will be selected for the Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University Court. However, in the event less than seven candidates run for Mr. and or Miss Tennessee Tech the court size will be reduced. Below is a brief outline of policies and procedures for election/selection.

Candidates Meeting: The official Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University candidates meeting will be Thursday, October 18th at 11:00 am in the SGA Office (RUC 208). Candidates must be present or have a representative present during the candidates meeting. The candidates must sign and initial a copy of the election rules and complete the candidate application in order to run.

Meet the Candidates: This is a forum that allows the student body to get to know the candidates and why they should be elected Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech. Each candidate will give a 90 second. After his or her speech the candidate will be asked a question. This event will be held in Derryberry Hall Auditorium on Tuesday, October 23rd at 6:00 pm.

Election Day: All qualified applicants will be placed on the ballot. Voting will be conducted online on Thursday, October 25th from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm. The 14 qualified candidates (seven Mr. Tennessee Tech candidates and seven Miss Tennessee Tech candidates) receiving the most votes by plurality will be named as members of the Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech Court. The Student Government Association will announce the court election results on the stage of Centennial Plaza and on social media accounts as soon as the polls close and the results are finalized. Please refer to the "Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University Election Rules 2018" that will be posted on the SGA website for more information about election rules and procedures.

Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University Court candidates may or may not be paired with the corresponding candidate that has the same election vote ranking. This pairing is how the Court will be presented in the 2018 Homecoming Parade. The official rank pairing will not be presented to the court until the halftime of the homecoming football game.

Rehearsal: The Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University Court candidates will have a mandatory rehearsal Friday, November 2, 2018 on the football field with the Golden Eagles Marching Band. The time will be announced closer to time.

Homecoming Parade: The Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University Court candidates will be featured in the 2018 Homecoming parade. The candidates are paired in the parade as mentioned earlier. It is the responsibility of the pair of candidates to find a car/transportation for the parade.

Announcement: The public announcement of the 2018 Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University will be made at the half-time ceremony of the football game Saturday, November 3, 2018.

Attire: Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University candidates are encouraged to wear Sunday best or formal attire that incorporates TTU spirit. Please note that the weather is usually cold at the game.

Presentation: The 2018 Mr. & Miss Tennessee Tech University representatives will be presented by the Tennessee Tech University President, First Lady, and the Student Government Association President.
