

An Act to Create an Intercollegiate Affairs Committee

Whereas, schools within Tennessee lack communication among Student Governments,
and,

Whereas, communication about Student Governments can stimulate ideas around campuses throughout the state, **and,**

Whereas, The Student Government of Tennessee Tech University can use ideas from other schools to innovate ideas on Tech's campus, and vice versa, **and,**

Whereas, Student Governments around the state can collaborate with intercollegiate ideas and projects, **and,**

Whereas, Students Governments can create resolutions to support other schools' Student Governments around the state,

NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

Section 1: This bill shall be known as the "Intercollegiate Affairs Committee Act of 2018"

Section 2: A new ad hoc committee will be implemented the following semester after approval of this act.

Section 3: Each committee member will be assigned a public university within Tennessee and collaborate with its Student Government.

Section 4: Other universities within the state will be encouraged to follow these steps and welcome an Intercollegiate Affairs Committee.

Section 5: This bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
