

An Act to Add Braille to Cafeteria Drink Stations

- Whereas,** Braille is located on only the manual Pepsi machines **and,**
- Whereas,** It should be added to other possible drink stations, **and,**
- Whereas,** TTU has a visually impaired population, though small, this will greatly help Their ability to become comfortable and enjoy campus, **and,**
- Whereas,** The cafeteria has the same teas, waters, and coffees daily which will make Labeling simple, **and,**
- Whereas,** The cost of braille stickers and maintenance would be extremely low, and Incredibly useful,

NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the “Cafeteria Braille Drink Station Act of 2018”.
- Section 2:** Braille stickers will be implemented for the labeling of all manual drinks Stations.
- Section 3:** Specifically, braille will be added to the sweet and unsweetened teas.
- Section 4:** Braille will be added to the coffee dispensers such as decaf, dark roast, medium roast, etc.
- Section 5:** Braille will be added to the infused water dispensers such as strawberry, lemon, orange, etc.
- Section 6:** The exact location of the braille is for cafeteria’s discretion granted it remains constant on drink dispensers and is easily accessible to visually impaired students.
- Section 7:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
