

**An Act to Increase Pedestrian Safety on North Dixie Avenue**

**Whereas,** pedestrians that are utilizing crosswalks on North Dixie Avenue during nighttime hours are in danger of being struck by vehicles **and,**

**Whereas,** Incidents of pedestrians being struck have been observed **and,**

**Whereas,** major improvement plans have been proposed to be implemented in the future to increase pedestrian safety **and,**

**Whereas,** pedestrian safety is still a concern until the improvements are complete **and,**

**Whereas,** reflectors would identify crosswalk locations at night alerting drivers that pedestrians may be crossing.

**NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE  
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

**Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the "North Dixie Avenue Pedestrian Safety Act of 2018"

**Section 2:** Reflectors will be installed at the four crosswalks between 9<sup>th</sup> street and 12<sup>th</sup> street on Dixie Avenue.

**Section 3:** In the event of the planned road improvements, the reflectors shall be taken up and saved for future use.

**Section 4:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, and the welfare of the students requiring it.
