

**An Act to Change the Tax Refunding Information in the SOLO Application**

- Whereas,** in the current SOLO application it does not state that tax is nonrefundable, **and,**
- Whereas,** it is not clear in the current application that tax will not be refunded by the SOLO fund to each organization, **and,**
- Whereas,** public college universities do not pay taxes therefore providing funding for an organization with school money can not be taxed, **and,**
- Whereas,** the bill would make the SOLO application more understandable before organizations fill it out, **and,**
- Whereas,** it would eliminate conflict and confusion when it comes time for SGA to refund the organization, **and,**
- Whereas,** it would make the SOLO application process easier to process as a whole,

**NOW THEREFORE,**

TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the “SOLO Application Tax Refund Information Act of 2018”
- Section 2:** On page six of the SOLO application, a section will be added under “Total amount needed from SOLO fund” that states: “(Tax is not refunded to the organization):”
- Section 3:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
