NOW THEREFORE,

Section 1: This bill shall be known as the "Student Government Transparency Act of 2018"

Section 2: Once a week, SGA will set up a table in the UC lobby.

Section 3: This table will be welcoming students to come express their concerns and comments.

Section 4: The table will be set up during dead hour (Tuesday or Thursday during 11am noon)

Section 5: Each SGA senator will be required to sit at the table once per year (2 semesters).

Section 6: This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
