NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT

Section 1: This bill shall be known as the "Increase Club and Organization Recognition Act

of 2018"

Section 2: During sporting events, there will be a time set aside for recognition of different

clubs and organizations around campus.

Section 3: The time for this will be allotted based on the sport and how the athletic

department sees fit.

Section 4: The club being recognized will be decided on by the Secretary of External Affairs.

Section 5: This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government

Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
