

**An Act to Clarify and Digitalize the SOLO Application**

- Whereas,** the current SOLO application does not have certain guidelines listed, **and**
- Whereas,** Student Organizations need to be aware of all rules and regulations for SOLO funding, **and**
- Whereas,** Student Organizations need transparency throughout the process, **and**
- Whereas,** Student Organizations also need accessibility to the newest version of the application, **and**
- Whereas,** electronic applications provide immediate submission, while tangible applications have delayed submission, **and**
- Whereas,** some SOLO applications need immediate submission as the events are soon after the monetary request

**NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE  
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the “The SOLO Clarification and Digitalization Act of 2018”
- Section 2:** The Current SOLO application will be replaced with an online application.
- Section 3:** The online application will then follow a completely revised “SOLO Funding Process Guidelines Form.”
- Section 4:** The Treasurer of the Student Government, the SOLO committee, and the Dean of Students Office shall review and make any necessary amendments once a semester.
- Section 5:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
