NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the "Addition of the Pharmabox in the New, Lab Science Building Act of 2021."
- Section 2:** The Pharmabox will be placed on the first floor of the New Lab Science Building.
- Section 3:** The merchandise within the vending machine will be chosen by Health Services.
- Section 4:** Tennessee Tech will receive revenue from the sales of the box.
- Section 5:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.


