

SGA Bill SB-S23-04
An Act to Increase Motorcycle Parking on Campus

- Whereas,* Due to lack of available motorcycle parking at all corners of campus, there is conflict in where you can park despite your parking pass availability if you own a motorcycle; and
- Whereas,* this causes motorcycle riders to park in regular parking spots which take up more space and underutilize the space available compared to the smaller more appropriate motorcycle parking spaces; and,
- Whereas,* A normal parking spot can accommodate 2 or 3 motorcycle parking spots which in turn leads to more concise and appropriate parking; and,
- Whereas,* Due to the transition of The College of Business to Foundation Hall and the influx of incoming freshman it seems appropriate to accommodate these areas accordingly.

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT

- Section 1: This Bill shall be known as the “Motorcycle Parking Act of 2023”.
- Section 2: This bill will add four motorcycle parking spots at the back corner of Bell Hall Parking lot in exchange for two red parking spots.
- Section 3: This Bill will add four motorcycle parking spots at an unused portion of Foundation Hall Parking lot.
- Section 4: The new instated Motorcycle Parking Spots will be accessible to the appropriate parking pass available in these areas.
- Section 5: This Bill shall take effect immediately following passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
