### Guidelines:

- Any faculty member, including adjuncts who have demonstrated exceptional service learning initiatives through the University, is eligible.
- Any students, faculty, administrators or staff may make a nomination.
- Recipient will be recognized at an awards ceremony and will be presented with a framed certificate.

Eligibility for nomination and for the award will be determined according to the following definition:

**Service-Learning is** a teaching and learning strategy that integrates meaningful community service with instruction and reflection to enrich the learning experience, teach civic responsibility, and strengthen communities.--Learn & Serve National Clearinghouse
